

Benoxinate hydrochloride

Benoxiate hydrochloride belongs to the group of local anesthetics. The active substance numbs quickly, but not for long. It is used for the treatment of pain, mostly in the mouth area (dental medicine), but also for local inflammation in the throat and pharynx area.
