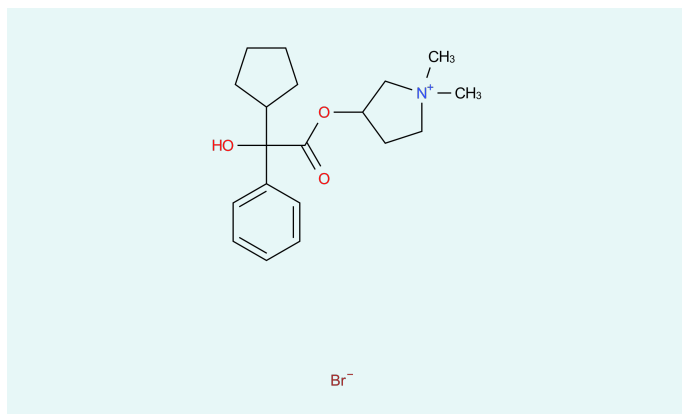


Glycopyrrolate bromide
