

## Tenofovir disoproxil fumarate

Tenofovir disoproxil fumarate is a nucleotide analogue that belongs to the nucleotide reverse transcriptase inhibitors (NtRTI). It is incorporated by viruses instead of deoxyadenosine triphosphate (dATP) (competitive inhibition), but the chemical structure leads to chain termination in any case. It is used in the treatment of HIV-1 infections and hepatitis B.
